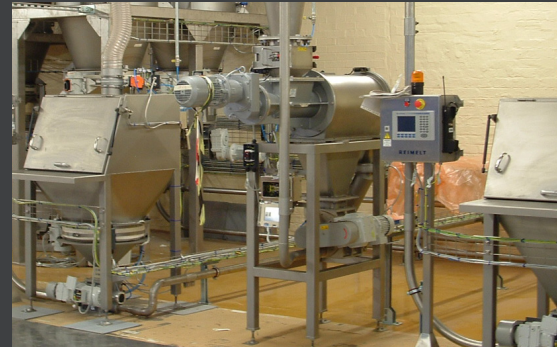

CDM Coordinator

The Construction (Design and Management) Regulations 2007 place legal duties on almost everyone involved in construction work.

FEG ensure that all of these duties are carried out so our clients have an effective Health and Safety Management Plan to prevent accidents prior to, during and after larger construction projects.

CDM coordinator's main duties are to:

- Advise and assist clients with their legal duties
- Define and Outline the Construction Project
- Consider if construction work is a Notifiable Project
- Notify details of the project to HSE
- Coordinate health and safety aspects of design work
- Cooperate with others involved within the project
- Facilitate good communication between the client, designer and principal contractor
- Liaise with the principal contractor regarding ongoing design work
- Identify, collect and pass on pre-construction information
- Prepare and update the health and safety file
